Winter classes did not all run: there are many classes which are repeats, as such they need 10 people to run. We discussed changing the threshold back to 5 people, but paying the instructors less money. After discussion, we decided that overall, the new class proposals coming in are mostly new and improved. We will keep the policy in place (5 people needed to run a new class, 10 needed for a repeat class).

We reviewed the application for professional learning opportunities. Everyone will look it over and if there are no issues we will disseminate with teachers for the 2025-2026 school year.

We had our third New Teachers's Night Out on March 8. We thought it was good, but not the best of the three. We think there were too many topics that weren't cohesive. Our focus on May 8 will be the union. Jaimie Ciffone will attend so we are hopeful it will be a real success.

NYSUT report: NYSUT is working on the Fix Tier 6 campaign. There will be rallies around the state on April 6. Information will be sent out to union leaders soon. The union will be focusing on protecting unions, getting ready for the unknown, focusing on issues, and getting people to reach out to our leaders no matter the party.
